1.1 Improvements

- Added support for the following TriCaster Flex Dual new features: Spacers/Blank button mapping, Media Player LCD layout and information, Blinking Crosspoints, One-button Stripe Delegates, OUT All delegate, MIX All delegate, Assignable Multipads, Feature Toggle delegate, Z-Priority option for Multipads, Teleprompter controls, and Panel Lock/Unlock.

1.2 Bug Fixes

- Fixed an issue with Gemini control surface that left a keyer delegate active to change sources.
 - Fixed an issue seen when opening Flex Control Panel's webpage in an HTML Buffer window would not open drop-down menus correctly.
 - Fixed an issue where after changing the Mix Output format, a session restart would reset the format to the session format.
 - Fixed an issue where Display name changes of media files were being reverted when a file was copy/cut and pasted between media bins.
 - Fixed an issue with a Mix/Effect shortcut that would not load the correct preset.
 - Fixed an issue with Flex Control Panel (One stripe) not following Rate changes made in the UI.
 - Fixed an issue where a user could not disable Keying in the UI if Keying were enabled using a macro/shortcut.
 - Incorporated a 135ms timeout period when loading EMEMs to prevent UI crashes.
 - Fixed an issue where a session could crash after a few hours of being open.
 - Fixed an issue with the New Teams client not being recognized by Live Call Connect.
