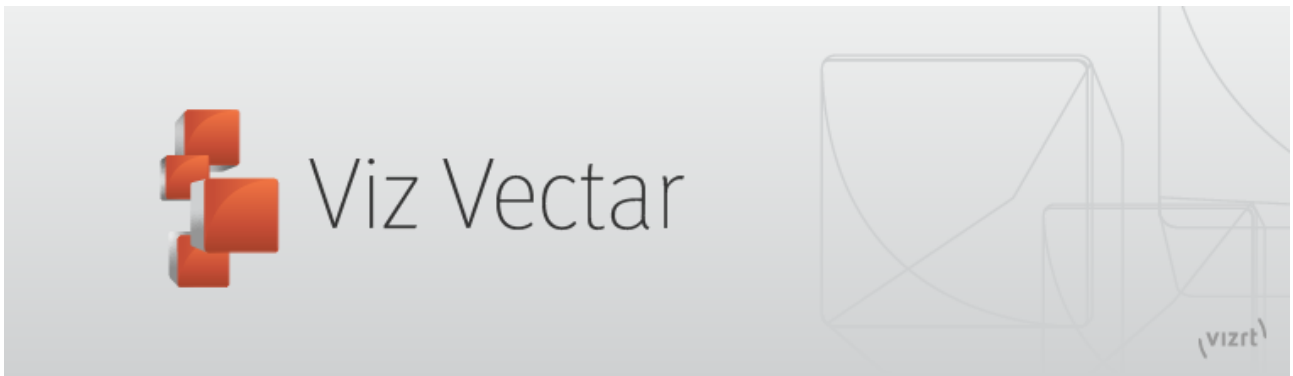

2.1 Improvements

- Changed the name of the Export preset SMTP to Email.
 - Added a shortcut option to enable/disable the Export option, and added a shortcut that toggles the state of the preset.

2.2 Bug Fixes

- Fixed a slow memory leak when using Spark Pro as NDI Input.
- Fixed an issue where exporting a clip with only an In point set would cause the entire clip to export.
- Fixed a CS issue where selecting sources on the switcher row over long periods of time could cause shortcut issues.
- Fixed an issue where recording was not possible when Multicast was enabled.
- Fixed an issue in the Macro Editor where setting a Boolean value when a shortcut requires a numerical value can cause the switcher to terminate unexpectedly.
- Fixed an issue where clip options menu would not display available replay Angles.
- Fixed an issue where, in rare cases, the custom Macro folders could be deleted.
- Fixed an issue where camera zoom control was inconsistent when using a BirdDog PTZ camera and an IP Control Surface.
